YMCA Camp Ingersoll Ultimate Fishing Camp

Dear Parents and Campers,

Welcome to YMCA Camp Ingersoll's new Ultimate Fishing Camp. Once again Ultimate fishing has gone through some modifications combine the camp experience with a more varied fishing experience.

Ultimate Fishing will still follow the traditional specialty camp model. For seven out of the ten days of the session your campers will fish in the morning and participate in general camp activities in the afternoon. In the morning campers will have activity based instruction including topics such as: casting, types of bait, where fish hide, fishing safely, and equipment maintenance; and of course they will have plenty of time to fish. Newly added this year will be two morning trips on the first Thursday and Friday of the session. They will travel with Horseback one day, and Golf the other, to local hot spots in Glastonbury and Middlefield. On these days they are also able to participate in a traditional camp afternoon consisting of periods of free swim, nature, archery, ropes, and so on. Therefore, instead of our fishermen and women having a great fishing experience and missing out on camp, they get the best of both worlds!

You will receive an itinerary about two weeks prior to each session. In addition to our daily activities, as stated above, there will be three field trips. On the second Tuesday of each session campers will travel to the MiJoy747 in Waterford. They will depart on the boat around 1pm and return around 7pm. After stopping to eat campers should arrive at camp around 9pm when they will then need to be picked up. **There are no more fishing overnights at Camp Ingersoll.** On the second Thursday there is a trip to Black Rock State Park and the following day they will be traveling to Rocky Neck State Park.

Each day camper should be prepared with the proper gear:

- 1) Dress for the weather. We will still be fishing in inclement weather, with the exception of thunderstorms and extreme weather conditions.
- 2) Be sure to pack a lunch with a drink each day. **Fishing camp can now sign up for subway lunches as well.** We encourage campers to bring along an extra drink, as water fountains may not be available everywhere.
- 3) Closed toed shoes that can get wet. Keep in mind that we will be near the water each day, and in safe situations, may be wading (If a lifeguard is present).
- 4) Clothing such as: A swimsuit, long pants, a sweatshirt, a towel, sunscreen and a hat for shade, should be brought everyday.
- 5) Any fishing gear (EXCLUDING KNIFES) that you may need. Please remember that we will be traveling in a school bus, and storage space is limited. (We do supply fishing poles if you require one.)

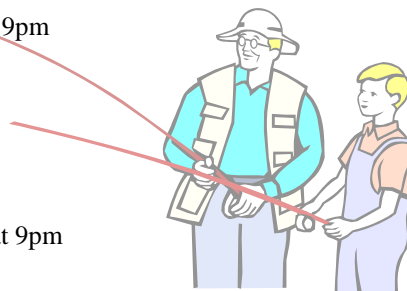
