



YMCA Camp Ingersoll Henry W. Coe Scholarship



The Henry W. Coe Scholarship is named in honor of one of YMCA Camp Ingersoll's most passionate and prolific leaders. For more than 30 years, Henry Coe spent the school year as a teacher in Durham and Middlefield's District 13 and spent the summer as the seasonal director at YMCA Camp Ingersoll. Henry's dedication to supporting young people in academic pursuits and character development is unmatched. The award recipients must demonstrate that they possess the desire to impact the lives of young people in much the same way Henry Coe has done.

Eligibility:

All candidates must be employees of YMCA Camp Ingersoll during the summer of application. All candidates must be enrolled in a full time college program and be pursuing a career in a youth service related field.

Awards:

Cameron Award: \$500 will be awarded to a staff member entering his or her freshman year of college.
Taylor Award: \$1000 will be awarded to a staff member entering an upper class year of college.

All awards will be paid by check directly to the student and will be presented at the staff banquet. Awards are intended to assist recipients with covering costs of materials directly related to the field of study i.e. books, training materials, etc.

Guidelines:

The Henry W. Coe Scholarship will be awarded to YMCA Camp Ingersoll staff members that have successfully completed the application packet and have demonstrated the values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility in their work with children over the course of the summer.

The selection committee will consist of volunteers including staff members, parents, and YMCA employees. One YMCA Camp Ingersoll Senior Staff member will serve on the committee as a non-voting member, helping to coordinate the process. Committee members that are applying for the scholarship or are related to a candidate will be asked to remove themselves from the selection committee.

Applications must be complete and turned in to the YMCA Camp Ingersoll office no later than **9:00 AM on the second Friday of session 3.** No applications will be accepted late and incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applications become the property of YMCA Camp Ingersoll and will not be returned to the candidates. All applicants agree to let YMCA Camp Ingersoll use their name, image and sections of their application for promotional use.
